## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Horses on the showground must be fully vaccinated up to date, passport must be brought with your horse and spot checks on the day could be carried out

- Riders can enter up to 2 classes
- Times will be emailed to you on the *Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2024*
- Please make sure all droppings and hay cleared up from outside your trailer/lorry

1. The competition is run under British Dressage rules
2. There are toilet facilities on site
3. Numbers in the warm up arena will be limited
4. No trainers allowed in the warm up area
5. Score board will be by secretary box
6. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times
7. Please use your own bridle / saddle cloth numbers. **Must have two numbers, one on each side**
8. No Stallions are permitted on the show ground
9. ROSETTES to 6<sup>th</sup> place in each section.
10. ENTRIES will close prior to the closing date if full. PRIORITY entry will be provided to club members
11. HORSES & PONIES must be 4 years and above to enter, only those entered to be brought onto the showground.
12. HEALTH & SAFETY The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
13. LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused.
14. HARD HATS to BSI standard PAS 015 –En 1384 or ASTM F1163 must be worn at all times whilst mounted with harness in place.
15. CORRECT FOOTWEAR must be worn when mounted.
16. DOGS must be kept on leads at all times.
17. REFUNDS for entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.
18. OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a £10.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.
19. RESERVATION The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.
20. LITTER must be taken home, and horse-boxes must not be mucked out on the premises.
21. FOUL Language and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated.
22. The Judge's decision is FINAL.
